

**BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN  
ORDINANCE 17-1448**

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF  
MILLTOWN AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR THE YEARS  
2017, 2018 AND 2019**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Milltown, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the following salaries and wages shall be paid to the various officials and employees of the Borough of Milltown as are hereinafter specified, to take effect upon the anniversary of employment for each individual employee:

**SECTION 3.** Compensation for services of a special nature beyond the regular routine business of official officers shall be authorized by appropriate resolution.

**SECTION 4.** The position of "Part Time Office Help" will be removed from the Salary Ordinance. Those currently serving as "Part Time Office Help" will be reassigned to the position of "Part Time Clerk 1" upon final adoption and publication of the ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewithin are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective upon final publication as required by law.
