

Ordinance #10-1297

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES FOR VARIOUS OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR THE YEARS 2008, 2009 AND 2010

SECTION 2.

The salaries of the Borough Attorney, Engineer, Tax Assessor, Construction Code Official, Building Sub-Code Official, Electric Sub-Code Official, Plumbing Sub-Code Official, Construction Office Control Clerk, School Nurse, Fire Sub-Code Official, Animal Control Officer, and Municipal Magistrate shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

The salary of the Municipal Court Recorder, Municipal Prosecutor and Municipal Public Defender shall be paid on a per meeting appearance basis on voucher submitted for said court session attended.

SECTION 3.

All other employees of the Borough of Milltown shall be paid on Thursday of every other week.

SECTION 4.

The salaries of the Superintendent of Electric Utility & Water/Sewer Utility, Summer Recreation Program Supervisor, Certified Adult Group Leaders, Non-Certified Adult Group Leaders, Teen Counselors and SACC Site Director, Assistant Program Manager, Adult Aide and Teen Aide shall be set by Resolution of the Borough Council within the ranges established herein.

SECTION 5.

Compensation paid to the Borough Clerk, Borough Tax Collector, Business Administrator, Chief Finance Officer, Director of Social Services, Municipal Magistrate, Construction Code Official, Building Sub-Code Official, Electric Sub-Code Official, Plumbing Sub-Code Official, Fire Sub-Code Official, Director of Recreation and Parks and Zoning Official shall be in lieu of all statutory fees.

SECTION 6.

The compensation paid to the Lifeguards, Gate Attendants, Part-Time Communications Operators, Temporary Office Help and Recreation Instructors and Supervisors shall be paid for the time worked as submitted on payroll voucher for appropriate Council approval.

Ordinance #10-1298

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN, MORE PARTICULARLY, CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC"; TO AMEND SECTION 7-14, PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIME ON CERTAIN STREETS: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF VANDERBILT AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Milltown of the County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey that the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Milltown be amended as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 7, "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Milltown is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. The following part of Section 7-14, Parking Prohibited at all Times on Certain Streets, shall be amended to add the following:



Vanderbilt Avenue	North	Beginning at North Main Street and Continuing east 197 feet 4 inches

Section 3. Each clause, section or subsection of the ordinance shall be deemed a separate provision to the intent that if any such clause, section or subsection should be declared invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.


