

**DEPARTMENT OF CODE ENFORCEMENT**  
**ACTIVITY REPORT: June 12, 2017**

As previously reported, due to issues with the fire suppression water line running through the Ford Avenue complex, the demolition and cleanup has been temporarily stopped. A meeting last week with the principle contractor for the property owner was held on site to determine a new schedule for completion of the debris cleanup and demolition of the remaining buildings. The property owners are currently working on a plan to install a new water line to be used for the fire suppression only for the remaining occupied buildings and the cleanup and demolition is expected to resume within the next two weeks. A municipal court date has been rescheduled for June 15, 2017, in order to give the judge an update on the project.

In conjunction with the Ford Avenue demolition project, the fishing ban is still in effect for Mill Pond and the surrounding waterways. In a conversation with a representative of the Division of Fish & Wildlife, we have been advised that the ban will hopefully be lifted within the next two to three weeks now that the testing has taken place and the State is awaiting the results.
