**NOTICE OF HERBICIDE AS PART OF VEGETATION MANGEMENT WORK ON  
PSE&G EASEMENT**

Dear Property Owner,

Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) utilizes the electric transmission right-of-way located on your property. The electric transmission lines on this right-of-way are essential for PSE&G to meet its commitment to provide safe, proper and adequate electric service to consumers throughout New Jersey. Maintaining proper tree clearance from the power lines is absolutely necessary to assure:

- The continued safety of homeowners living near the transmission lines,
- The safety of PSE&G employees and contractors working on the power lines, and
- The reliability of the electric utility system.

The number and size of overgrown trees and other vegetation on the right-of-way now requires maintenance of the right-of-way. As such, Davey Tree Expert Co., Inc., a private contractor working for PSE&G, will **APPLY HERBICIDE** to brush and woody vegetation on PSE&G's Right of Way. Our crews will only apply herbicide to selective vegetation and will only treat what needs to be treated. We will mostly treat stumps from trees that we (Davey Tree Expert) cut down during our maintenance of the Right of Way. This work will begin; weather permitting, on or about February 2017 through March 2017
