**THE CLEANUP AND REMOVAL OF MATERIALS AND DEBRIS FROM THE DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AT THE FORD AVENUE SITE HAS BEGUN AGAIN AFTER A SHORT SHUTDOWN OF THE PROJECT DUE TO CONTRACTUAL ISSUES WITH THE HAULERS AND PROPERTY OWNER. APPROXIMATELY 110 LOADS OF MATERIAL HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM THE SITE, DEMOLITION WILL COMMENCE ON THE PORTIONS OF THE BUILDINGS STILL REMAINING.**

**IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CLEANUP, THE CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT HAS ALSO ASCERTAINED THE STATUS OF THE FISHING BAN CURRENTLY IN PLACE FOR THE MILL POND AREA. IN SPEAKING WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT BUREAU FOR THE DIVISION OF FISH & WILDLIFE, I WAS INFORMED THAT THE FISHING BAN IS STILL IN PLACE AND THAT THE BIOLOGIST FOR FISH & WILDLIFE IS AWAITING ADDITIONAL TEST RESULTS TO DETERMINE HOW LONG THE FISHING BAN WILL REMAIN IN PLACE. ADDITIONAL SIGNAGE HAS BEEN POSTED ALONG THE BOROUGH SIDE OF THE WATERWAY WARNING INDIVIDUALS OF THE CONTINUED FISHING BAN. ON A POSITIVE NOTE, THE BOROUGH REMAINS ON THE RESTOCKING LIST FOR MILLPOND WITH THE DIVISION OF FISH AND WILDLIFE AND ACCORDING TO THE DIVISION, SAID RESTOCKING WILL TAKE PLACE AS SOON AS THE TEST RESULTS PROVIDE A POSITIVE RESULT.**
