Dear Valued Customer:

Public Service Electric & Gas Company (PSE&G) and our contractors have begun activities along the existing right-of-way in proximity to your property as part of the Metuchen-Trenton-Burlington transmission project. This project is designed to strengthen the electric transmission system for electric customers in this region.

The 55-mile reliability project, which runs from PSE&G's Metuchen Switching Station in Edison to Burlington Switching Station in Burlington, replaces critical infrastructure that has reached its end of life. On average, these transmission facilities are 80-plus years old.

You may see our crews on the right-of-way performing survey work and verifying subsurface conditions and underground utilities. In addition, you may see construction activities to support the replacement of the electric infrastructure. Safety is our highest priority at PSE&G, and it is essential that you and anyone occupying your property refrain from going on the right-of-way during these activities.
