ORDINANCE #19-1474

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES FOR VARIOUS EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Milltown, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

That the following salaries and wages shall be paid to the various officials and employees of the Borough of Milltown as are hereinafter specified, to take effect May 14, 2019:

**SECTION 3.** The salaries of the SACC Site Directors/Program Supervisors, Assistant Program Supervisors, Program Aides and Assistant Program Aides shall be set by Resolution of the Borough Council within the ranges established herein.



**SECTION 5.** Compensation for services of a special nature beyond the regular routine business of officials or other employees shall be authorized by appropriate Resolution of the Borough Council.


**SECTION 6.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent here within are hereby repealed.
