

**BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN  
ORDINANCE 21-1497**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF  
MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL EMERGENCY  
APPROPRIATION OF \$141,354.28 PROVIDING FOR THE FUNDING OF A DEFICIT IN  
OPERATIONS OF THE BOROUGH DIRECTLY ATTRIBUTABLE TO COVID-19 WHICH IS  
ANTICIPATED TO BE EXPERIENCED BY THE BOROUGH IN THE CURRENT FISCAL  
YEAR**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of New Jersey (the "State") has heretofore declared a public health emergency and a state of emergency in response to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019 as announced by the World Health Organization on February 11, 2020, and first identified in Wuhan, China ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(m) provides that a municipality may, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (the "Director"), adopt an ordinance providing for a special emergency appropriation for the funding of a deficit in operations of the Borough directly attributable to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Milltown, in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey (the "Borough") has executed a certification in the form prescribed by the Director, certifying that the deficit balance anticipated to be reported on the Borough's "Results of Operations" schedule of the annual financial statement for the current fiscal year is \$141,354.28; and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on April 12, 2021, the Municipal Council of the Township approved such certification, together with the Borough's application to the Director seeking approval of the adoption of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Borough has determined to provide for the funding of such anticipated operating deficit balance, as offset by the amount of financial assistance received, in the net amount of \$141,354.28.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE  
BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, AS  
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(m), the sum of \$141,354.28 is hereby appropriated for the funding of a deficit in operations of the Borough directly attributable to COVID-19 which is anticipated to be experienced by the Borough in the current (2020) fiscal year, and the same shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53.

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Section 2. The portion of the authorization financed shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least one fifth of the amount authorized by this ordinance and financed and as provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

Section 3. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law; provided that the approval of the Director has been obtained.


